Registration, Concession Stand, and Trail Hike Kick-off are located at the City West Shelter. Registration begins at 8:00 a.m. and the hike kicks-off at 9:00 a.m.

Please conform to the wishes of the park staff:

1. No dogs or pets are permitted,
2. No walking on the lake ice, and
3. Stay on approved/marked trails.

**Highlights: On Saturday, March 27, 2010, Michigamea Lodge 110 will host the 54th Annual Potawatomi Trail Hike. This a five or ten-mile hike available to all organizations. We welcome Tiger Cubs, Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Explorers, Venturing Crews, and Families.**

The hike traditionally attracts over 1,500 visitors and takes place regardless of rain or snow.

The Order of the Arrow Concession Stand will offer coffee, donuts, pop, hotdogs, chips, candy, and hot chocolate.

**Cost:** No advanced registration is necessary. See other side for Unit Registration. Bring this with you to the Hike. DO NOT register at the Council Office.

**The \$4.00 registration fee includes the 2010 Potawatomi Hike Trail Patch.**

The Indiana State Park may charge a daily entrance fee of \$5.00 per vehicle with Indiana License Plates and \$10.00 per vehicle with Out-of-State License Plates. The entrance fee for a bus is \$1.00 per person on board the bus.
