Requirements

- A registered member of the Calumet Council (or prior approval of the Council Office).
- Attend a Council Campmaster Training Session.
- A willingness to serve at least twice a year as a Campmaster at Camp Betz.
- Have a current Boy Scout “Youth Protection Training” Certificate.
- Be currently Certified in CPR , basic First Aid and usage of the A.E.D.
- Willing to share some program specialty or skill with the Scouts while you are serving as Campmaster.

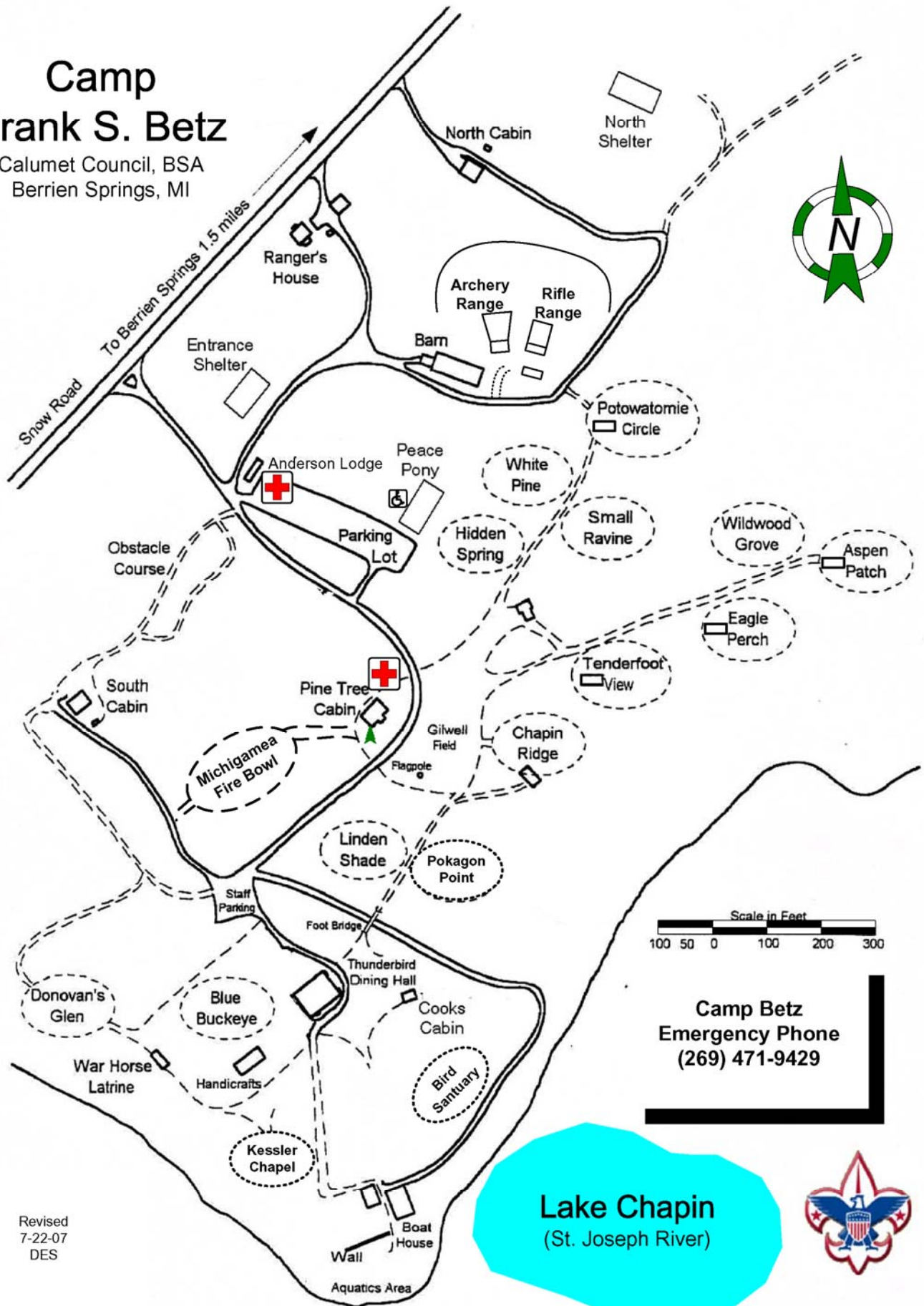


Campmaster Duties

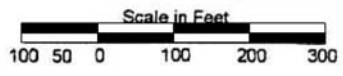
1. Check with the Camp Ranger by Monday evening preceding weekend duty.
2. Personally contact all leaders of units to be in camp on assigned weekend at least 3 weeks prior to the weekend. Introduce yourself and offer assistance in planning for the weekend.
3. Arrive at camp prior to the time the first unit arrives at camp.
4. Check in with the Camp Ranger on arrival at camp and obtain checkin material and other materials and instructions as provided by the Scout executive.
5. Assist the camp ranger in checking in units. Make sure checkin forms are filled out completely and that each campsite is shown on the camp map. Make announcements and give instructions to each unit as necessary for the weekend.
6. Park all vehicles as directed by the camp ranger.
7. Make every effort to promote conservation by encouraging all leaders and their units to complete work on a conservation project. Discuss the Outdoor Code with each unit.
8. Offer to Scouting units any special Scouting skills you may have in nature, hobbies, merit badge counseling, or the camp program.
9. You should determine that adequate plans have been made by each unit so that each Scout can properly fulfill his religious obligations.
10. Each campsite should be visited to ensure safe camping and to get to know the adult leaders, thus promoting a better camping spirit and cooperation.
11. You should supply your own transportation, bedding and food. The campmasters' quarters and cooking facilities shall be left each weekend in a clean and sanitary condition.
12. You should wear the official Scout Leader's uniform at all times while on duty.
13. You must call the camp ranger and Scout Executive if you are instructed to do so by the council in case of any serious emergency.
