

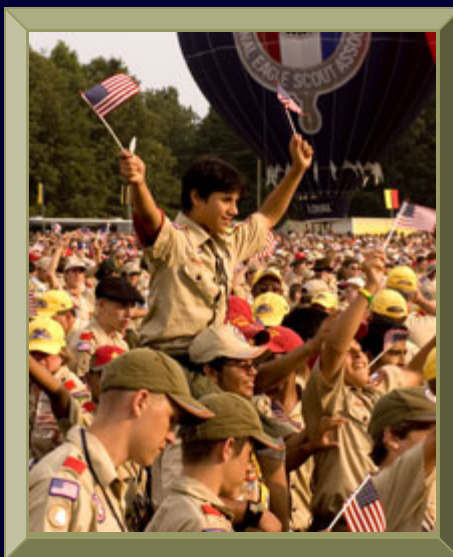

This award is a national recognition for individuals who contribute \$1,000 or more in cash to their local council's endowment fund. Your contribution is in addition to, and does not diminish or replace, your annual gift to the Friends of Scouting Campaign.

One way to become a James E. West Fellow is to enroll yourself. You can also honor someone else with this special award. On the back you will find a list of possible honorees. Your gift is safely invested in the council permanent endowment trust fund. Only the interest earned from that investment will be used for current programs. The principal amount is never invaded or expended. Therefore, your gift will last forever and will continue to support Scouting in perpetuity beyond your lifetime.

EASY TO ENROLL

Make a single payment of \$1,000 or, become a sustaining member with a payment plan of your own choosing. The Fellowship Award will be presented to you when the full payment is completed. You may select a sustaining membership plan with four (4) quarterly payments of \$250 or, ten (10) monthly payments of \$100 or, sixteen (16) monthly payments of \$62.50, fitting easily into your family budget. Payments can be made by cash, check or credit card.



NATIONAL RECOGNITION

Recognition for the award includes: an attractive 8-by-10 inch personalized certificate, a distinctive lapel pin, an embroidered knot for uniform wear, and a collectors, limited edition *James E. West Fellowship Award* council shoulder patch.
