Adult Leaders Needed: The Calumet Council is currently looking for adult leaders for the 2013 National Scout Jamboree to be held July 15 through the 24, of 2013 (does not include travel and tour dates) at Fort A.P. Hill, Virginia.

Organization: The Calumet Council contingent will consist of three Boy Scout troops and one Venture Patrol. Each troop will have 36 youth and 4 adult leaders. The Venture Patrol will have 8 youth and 1 leader. The basic qualifications for each adult troop leadership position are:

-Scoutmaster and First Assistant Scoutmaster: Have served as a Scoutmaster for at least one year during the three-year period prior to July 1, 2013; have completed basic Scoutmaster training; participate in a pre-jamboree training experience; file a personal health and medical record prior to the pre-jamboree training; participate in Jamboree Committee Meetings; be approved by the local council. (Although not required, Wood Badge and/or Scoutmaster's Key is a desirable qualification.) The Scoutmaster must be able to serve as a role model of physical fitness.

-Second Assistant Scoutmaster: At least 21 years of age by July 1, 2013, and have served actively in an adult troop leadership position for at least one year during the three-year period prior to July 1, 2013; participate in a pre-jamboree training experience; file a personal health and medical record prior to the pre-jamboree training; participate in Jamboree Committee Meetings; be approved by the local council. (Although not required, Wood Badge is a desirable qualification.)

-Third Assistant Scoutmaster: At least 18 years of age (but not have reached 21) by July 24, 2013; have served actively in a Scout troop leadership position; participate in a pre-jamboree training; be approved by the local council.
